MEET YOUR PRESENTER



Peter Sankoff is an award-winning law professor and researcher at the University of Alberta, Faculty of Law. He also practices appellate law part-time with Bottos Law Group in Edmonton. Peter is one of Canada's leading authorities on the substantive criminal law and the law of evidence. He authors or co-authors leading texts on criminal law, and the law of evidence including *Witnesses* and the *Portable Guide to Witnesses*, and has been widely published in a number of the world's most distinguished academic journals. Peter graduated with a JD from the University of Toronto, Faculty of Law and subsequently worked as a law clerk for Madame Justice Claire L'Heureux-Dubé at the Supreme Court of Canada. After earning an LL.M. from Osgoode Hall (York University), he joined the federal Department of Justice where he worked as an advisor on human rights matters involving criminal justice. Peter has taught as an invited visiting professor at the University of Ottawa, Haifa University (Israel), the University of Melbourne (Australia), Lewis and Clark College of Law (Oregon), the University of Western Ontario, Niigata University (Japan), and the University of Auckland (New Zealand). Peter has won numerous teaching awards, including the 2016 Brightspace Award for Innovation in Teaching from the Society of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education. One of Peter's main objectives is to help law students, lawyers and members of the public learn more about how the law functions, and make learning complex legal concepts easier.
